

Tall Trees Trail

route summary

Location Blackwater

Length 2.2 km

Type Circular route for walkers



Start / Finish Blackwater car park (SU 266 057)
or
Brock Hill car park (SU 267 046)



Experience Woodland walking experience with views of the tall trees.



Facilities Blackwater car park has space for 50 cars with 10 spaces reserved for disabled visitors. It has toilets and disabled access toilets, picnic tables, bike racks and an information point.
Brock Hill is a Forestry Commission car park with space for 20 cars (none reserved) and picnic tables.

Tall Trees Trail *route summary (cont'd)*

Surface Compacted gravel with loose stones on the surface.



Narrowest Width 1.1m at the chicane barriers where the trail crosses the road.



Max Gradient 1:8 for 6m at the start of the trail.



Max Cross Slope Occasional short sections of cross slope up to a maximum of 1:16.

Hazards

- In places the path edge is undefined and light levels are variable.
- Protruding tree roots up to 5 cm.
- There is a 3cm step onto the bridge.
