Members

There are twenty one members of the New Forest National Park Authority and one vacancy. Twelve are appointed by local county and district councils. The Secretary of State for Environment Food and Rural Affairs appoints ten. Of these, six are appointed as representatives of the 'national' interest and four as representatives of parishes in the National Park. Members are responsible for setting policies and priorities, ensuring efficient and effective use of resources and that money is well spent. It is their job to represent the interests of the National Park and to balance out any conflicting pressures.

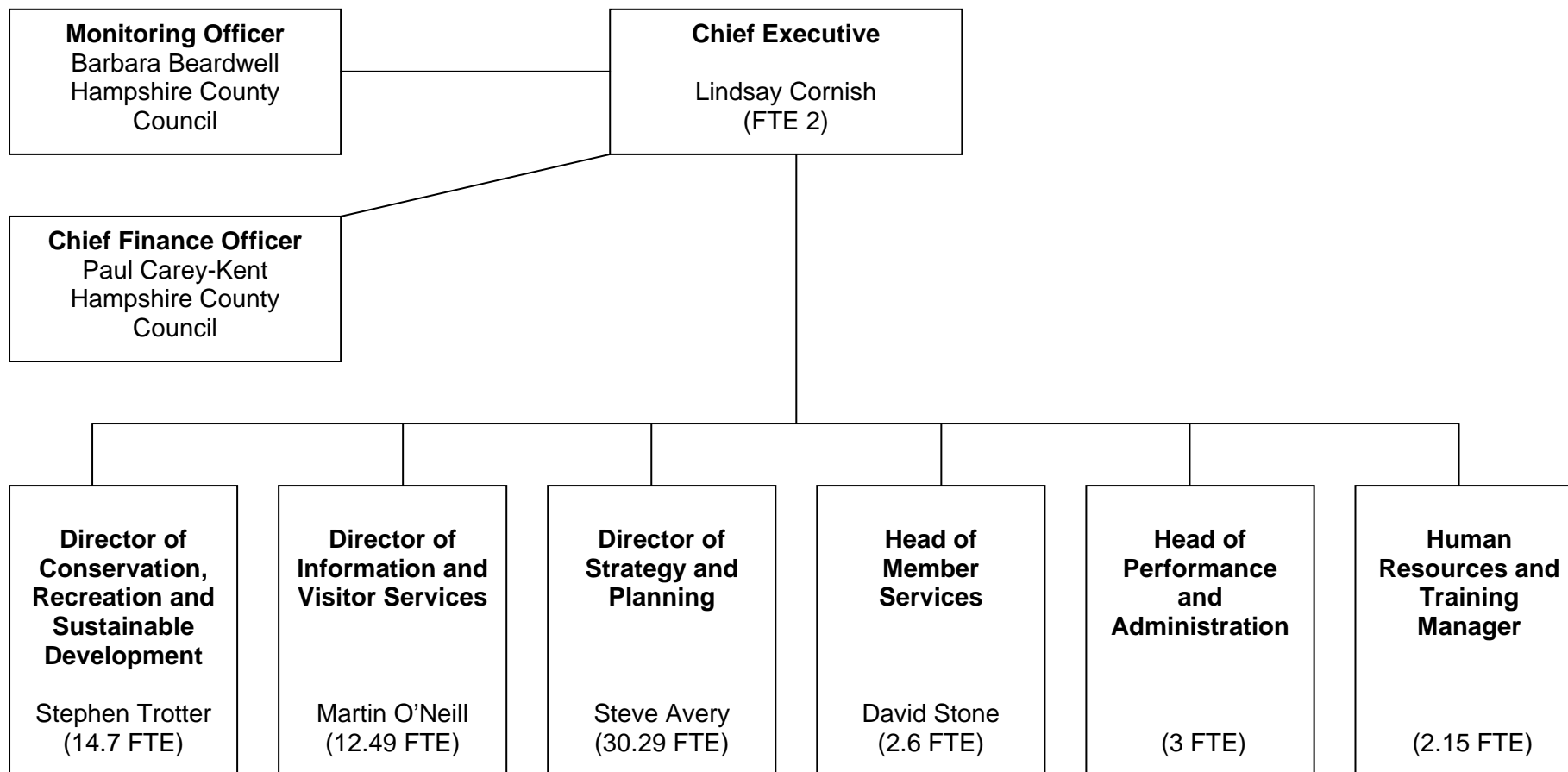
