| Facilities | Blackwater car park has space for 50 cars with 2 spaces reserved for disabled visitors. It has toilets and disabled access toilets, picnic tables, bike racks and an information point. |

Surface The surface is compacted gravel with some loose stones near the car park.



Narrowest Width 1.1m at the entrance gate to the Arboretum.

Max Gradient 38m of 1:10 on the approach to the arboretum from the car park.



Max Cross Slope There is virtually no cross slope.

Hazards There are protruding stones up to 2cm.

Gates There is one gate into the arboretum that is 1.1m wide.

Access Information

Car parking on a level area of short grass is available for radar key holders next to the Arboretum entrance gate.
