**NOTICE OF NEW FOREST NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY CORE STRATEGY AND
DEVELOPMENT MANAGEMENT POLICIES DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT
ADOPTION STATEMENT**

In accordance with the above regulations, notice is hereby given that New Forest National Park Authority adopted the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies Development Plan Document on 9 December 2010. The Core Strategy is a key part of the Authority's Local Development Framework and sets out the planning framework for the National Park which will guide development up to 2026. The Core Strategy includes both core policies and development management policies to take forward the vision, objectives and spatial strategy for the New Forest National Park.

Neil Pope, an Independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government considered the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD at an Examination in Public hearing sessions held between 7 September 2010 and 9 September 2010. The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations, was published on 8 October 2010. The adopted Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD contains the Inspector's recommendations that are binding on the Authority.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD may make an application under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 to the High Court on grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made by no later than the end of six weeks from the date of adoption of this Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD (i.e. by 28 January 2011)

Copies of the adopted Core Strategy and Development Management Policies DPD and associated documents, including the Inspector's binding report, Adoption Statement and Sustainability Appraisal are available for inspection at the Authority's Headquarters (South Efford House, Milford Road, Lymington SO41 0JD) (Monday – Friday 8.45am – 5.00pm) and the Reference Library at the New Forest Centre, Lyndhurst (Wednesday – Saturday 10.00am - 4.30pm).
