DOCUMENT' ADOPTION STATEMENT**

In accordance with the above regulations, notice is hereby given that the New Forest National Park Authority adopted the *New Forest National Park Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document* on 15 December 2011. The Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) is intended to inspire all applicants, their agents, architects and designers, to have regard to those features and rural characteristics that make the New Forest such a special place when formulating new development proposals.

The Design Guide SPD supports the planning policies within the Authority's *Core Strategy & Development Management Policies DPD* (December 2010), which sets out the planning framework for the National Park to guide development up to 2026. On adoption the SPD becomes a material consideration in the determination of planning applications throughout the National Park.

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Authority to adopt the *New Forest National Park Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document* may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from the date of adoption specified above.
