NOTICE OF NEW FOREST NATIONAL PARK DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT' ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with the above regulations, notice is hereby given that the New Forest National Park Authority adopted the *New Forest National Park Development Standards Supplementary Planning Document* on 27 September 2012. The Development Standards Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) supplements the policies in the Authority's adopted 'Core Strategy and Development Management Policies Development Management Document' (December 2010) and sets out more detail on the requirements for car parking provision associated with new development, sustainable construction and open space provision. The SPD also provides additional guidance on the Authority's affordable housing requirements and the consideration of development close to the protected New Forest habitats.

The document supplements the Core Strategy policies and is a material consideration in the determination of planning applications within the National Park.

Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Authority to adopt the *New Forest National Park Development Standards Supplementary Planning Document* may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from the date of adoption specified above.
