OPOF Event Volunteer (GNB)

Ground Nesting Bird awareness Runs April to July

We are seeking a number of volunteers to support our Rangers and seasonal Assistant Rangers in the promotion of responsible use of the forest during April, May and June, the Ground Nesting Bird season.

Working alongside Rangers and seasonal Assistant Rangers volunteers will:

- Visit car parks near to sensitive sites in our Mobile Information Unit (MU)
- Attend shows, fetes, fairs and events in the MU
- Undertake surveys to inform long term behaviour change efforts
- Distribute GNB posters and literature to relevant businesses

Volunteer Skills

We are looking for volunteers with a passion for wildlife, approachable, friendly, good communication skills, good at being part of a team and confident at engaging with the public. Existing knowledge about New Forest GNB's would be helpful but not essential as training and information packs will be provided.

Volunteering Opportunities

Rangers are out in the Forest 7 days a week during this time of the year. Volunteers will be

asked to book in for a day a week (in advance). The days could include early mornings, evenings and weekends, typically lasting from 2 to 6 hours.

Volunteer commitment

- Must be able to attend a minimum of two induction/training sessions towards the end of March to early April.
- Must be prepared to commit to attending at least 5 days during the season.

Essential Information

Single/Shared Role	Flexible, depending on the chosen role.
Estimated preferred hours per month	Minimum 5 days (e.g. 2 days per month)
Location	Flexible- across the New Forest National Park and surrounding area.
Training	All training will be provided in small groups or individually.
Expenses	Travel expenses can be reimbursed.
Dress code	A volunteer badge will be provided. For certain tasks and events other equipment will be provided as required.
