### **Hampshire Minerals and Waste Development Framework – Regulation 25 Consultation**

On 1 April 2006 the New Forest National Park Authority became the strategic and local planning authority with responsibility for minerals and waste planning. The National Park Authority resolved to undertake a joint Core Strategy on Minerals and Waste with Hampshire County Council, Portsmouth City Council and Southampton City Council.

The Hampshire Minerals and Waste Core Strategy was submitted to the Secretary of State in May 2006 and has been the subject of public consultation. However, that document currently sets out minerals and waste strategic policies for Hampshire only, thereby excluding that part of the National Park in Wiltshire (Salisbury District), as illustrated on the attached map. The National Park Authority intends to extend the Core Strategy to apply to that area of the National Park in Wiltshire (Salisbury District).

The National Park Authority now invites you to identify any key strategic issues on minerals and waste relating to the part of the National Park in Wiltshire that you think we should consider.

Please submit any comments on the Wiltshire area of the National Park to us at the following address no later than **9 August 2006**.
