BOUNDARY MARKERS AND INTERNAL REMINDER SIGN LOCATIONS

The map overleaf shows locations of **potential new boundary markers** where A and B roads enter the boundary of the National Park. Not all locations may be appropriate and some other minor roads might benefit from boundary markers.

Also indicated are locations of **existing 40mph zone signs** mounted on three-tiered posts. (These could be adapted to show the New Forest National Park logo and thereby become internal reminder signs. Large shield-shaped signs are usually located nearby.)

Other key locations need to be considered, such as the M27 near Ower, the A337 south from Cadnam and railway stations.
