## About National Park Management Plans

We have to have one (Environment Act 1995)
Includes a long-term Vision and objectives for the Park + priority actions

A plan for the place itself, not just the NPA
Needs support and involvement of all organisations and interests

## The current Management Plan

- Current plan published in 2010 following extensive public consultation

General agreement to the final plan

- Much of current plan still relevant, but
- actions need updating
- opportunity to directly involve all main partners


## A simple update proposed

- The current plan, vision and objectives left unchanged
- Short update to be prepared, to include:

Introduction - emphasis on partnership approach

- Looking back: examples of projects completed during last 5 years
- Recent changes in national policies, economy, local issues etc
- Actions for 2015-20 - from all organisations


## Where we have got to

- Partnership group of major Forest organisations - to steer and 'own' the plan
- Most Forest organisations / interests aware of ideas for update
- Partnership actions progressing - around 90 so far from 16 organisations
- Pulling together ideas for introductory chapters


## Consultation

- Working draft for consultation October / November (basic text document)
- General comments + your actions needed
- Individual meetings with many organisations and parishes (e.g. quadrants)
- Publicise via web, social media, exhibitions etc.
