


A day out in the New Forest

A day of two halves split between Longdown Activity Farm and the New Forest Wildlife Park, it'll be a fantastic day creating wonderful family memories. Children and adults alike are sure to enjoy this hands-on, up-close walk on the wild side.

Leave the car at home and jump on a train to Ashurst or park on the outskirts and take advantage of the eco-friendly bus routes which provide easy access into the heart of the New Forest.

# Morning

host of friendly animals to interact with. Bottle feed the kid goats and the calves, feed the ducks, cuddle the baby rabbits. You'll find out all about them and what they need in the fascinating daily talks and demonstrations.

# Afternoon

Walk on the wild side

Set in 25 acres of unspoilt woodland, the New Forest Wildlife Park is your playground for the afternoon. Immerse yourselves in the animals' environment and let the children get up close to Sika, Fallow and Roe deer that roam freely throughout the park. Owls and otters to wolves, bison, wild boar, red deer to Muntjac deer, Scottish wildcats and lynx, wallabies, water voles, adders, foxes, polecats, pine martins and ferrets, these are just some of the friends you'll encounter here.

Meet the experienced keepers and find out all about the animals that live in the park. Got a question you've always wanted to ask about wildlife? Now's your opportunity. They can tell you what otters like to eat and why wolves howl to name just two interesting facts.

There is also a fantastic adventure playground with a zip wire, log jumble, 'birds' nests' climbing ropes, swings, spider nets and more. For the younger members of the family, they can explore the sand pits, drive the diggers and clamber up the climbing frames.



# Evening

Feed your own little animals

After such a busy day, you'll be needing to feed your own little animals, so head back to Ashurst and settle in at the family-friendly New Forest Hotel, adjacent to Ashurst Station, for a sumptuous meal based on local New Forest produce.
