

Whitefield Moor

Connect with a wilder landscape on this riverside walk.



Ober Water Trail Short [1 mile / 1.6 km / Under 1 hour]

Follow the yellow trail markers for this lovely route. At bridge **B** there is a lovely view of the river and the only seat on the Trail. After the bridge there is a 1:8 slope for 3 metres off the bridge and 2 concrete outcrops although it's possible to pass to the side of them. To climb back onto the moor choose a route which suits you.

Ober Water Trail Long [1.5 miles / 2.4 km / Under 1 hour]

Follow the red markers for this longer route. Just beyond bridge **C**, a path to the right goes back very close to the river bank and is well worth a detour for views of the river. When you return over the Moor, if you keep south toward the road, the surface is much more level and you avoid the valley (see map).

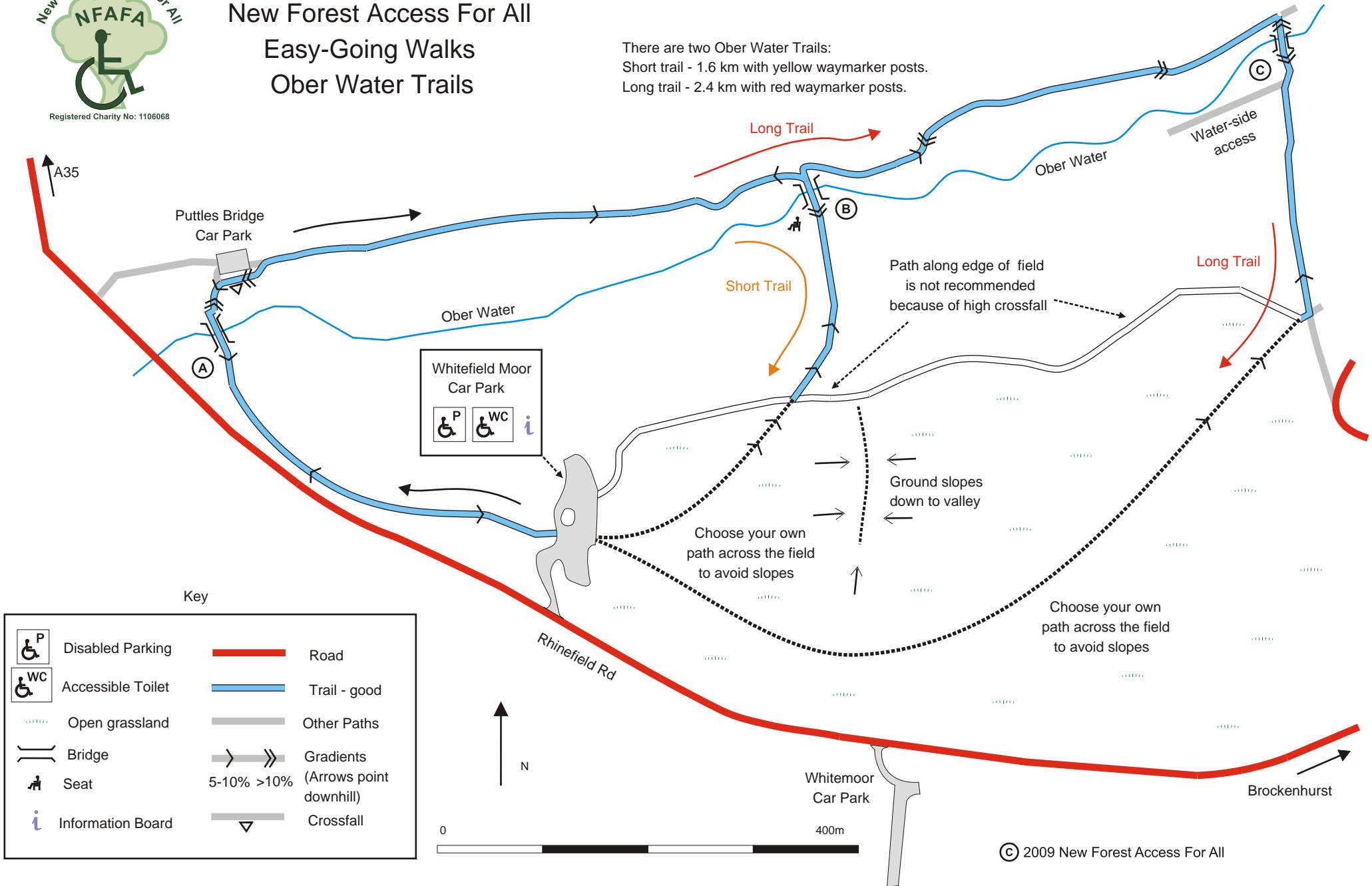
