Volunteers will be helping towards the Nature's Stepping Stones and Working Woodlands projects by enhancing the habitat for wildlife across sites in the New Forest.

Nature's Stepping Stones

'The Nature's Stepping Stones project is looking for volunteers to help in the winter by clearing invasive scrub from these grassland, heathland and wetland habitats. This involves cutting scrub using hand tools such as bowsaws and loppers. It is very rewarding work and we always have a nice bonfire to help us remove some of the cut material.' What to bring

Sturdy footwear, warm clothes and waterproofs (and if you have them: gardening gloves, loppers and bow saw. Otherwise, these will be provided). Please bring a packed lunch and a drink. You will be spending the day using hand tools to remove invasive scrub. Training on use of tools will be provided. Under 18's must be accompanied by an adult.
