

**Notice of Consultation and Statement of Representations Procedure**  
**New Forest National Park Submission Draft Local Plan 2016 – 2036**  
**Proposed Main Modifications**

**Title of the document:** New Forest National Park draft Local Plan 2016 – 2036: Proposed Main Modifications – April 2019.

**Subject matter and area covered by the document:** The National Park Authority has prepared the Regulation 19 draft Local Plan and this was submitted to the Secretary of State in Spring 2018 for independent examination. The Local Plan is a key document which sets out the spatial strategy for the National Park up to 2036 and includes specific planning policies to address the key issues facing the National Park. Following the Examination hearing sessions held between November 2018 – March 2019, the Authority has published a schedule of proposed Main Modifications to the wording of the Submission draft Local Plan.

**Period of publication for representations:** Representations are invited on the proposed schedule of Main Modifications between Tuesday 16 April and 12 noon on Friday 31 May 2019. Comments received outside these dates will not be accepted.
