	Fell 1 x Fir tree	Fir - previously damaged tree in Feb 2022 storms, losing a large branch damaging power cables as it came down. Felling the tree because it is a non-native, damaged fir tree where pollarding it would look ugly and the tree would not recover well. It is also very close (just 12 foot) to a nearby beech, which is a far nicer tree and would flourish better given more space.
	Fell 1 x Box Elder tree	Box Elder - box elder should be removed as it is in decline near another phone line. It is showing clear signs of decay towards the bottom of the trunk, and a couple of small branches have also fallen off. Removal of this tree would also benefit a nearby hornbeam by allowing more space.
