

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL PERMITTED DEVELOPMENT) (ENGLAND) ORDER 2015 (as amended)

NOTICE OF MAKING OF A NON-IMMEDIATE DIRECTION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 4(1) IN RESPECT OF ALL LAND IN THE NEW FOREST NATIONAL PARK

TAKE NOTICE that the above mentioned Direction was made pursuant to Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended, the **Order**) by the New Forest National Park Authority (the **Authority**), being the appropriate local planning authority, on 20 September 2021.

If it is confirmed by the Authority, the Direction will come into effect on **30 September 2022**.

The effect of the Direction will be to withdraw permitted development rights within **Classes B and BA of Part 4 of Schedule 2 of the Order** across the whole of the New Forest National Park in respect of any development of land consisting of use of that land as a temporary campsite unless both of the following apply:

- The number of pitches at the temporary campsite numbers 50 or fewer;
 and
- The land was first used as a temporary campsite before 1 March 2020.

Once the Direction comes into effect, any development of land consisting of the use of that land as a temporary campsite as described above will not be permitted unless express planning permission is granted by the Authority.

The Direction and accompanying Plan have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of the New Forest National Park Authority, Town Hall, Avenue Road, Lymington, Hampshire, SO41 9ZG, between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.00 pm Monday to Friday. Copies of the Direction and Plan are also available to view on the Authority's website at https://www.newforestnpa.gov.uk.

Any representations about the Direction should be made at any time from 27 September 2021 but no later than 7 November 2021 addressed to the Policy Manager, New Forest National Park Authority, Town Hall, Avenue Road, Lymington, Hampshire, SO41 9ZG or by email to policy@newforestnpa.gov.uk, quoting "Article 4 Direction – temporary campsites".

In deciding whether to confirm the Direction, the New Forest National Park Authority will take into account any representations that are received no later than 7 November 2021.
