




- 3x routes, 4x interchange points

Residents' tickets

- Saving of 30% on 1-day ticket for concession resident
- £2.27 per day based on daily use for concession resident
 - BUT it does require a smartphone and ID verification process
- NFDC information offices potentially assisting (TBC)
- Separately, 15% discount to one-day non-resident ticket purchases until 14 June




'More' - transport

NFNPA an engaged partner on:

- Bus Service Improvement Plan / 'Bus Back Better' for England & outside of London, slashed from £3bn to £1.4bn. 47/79 English local transport authorities awarded funding. HCC received £0.
- HCC's Local Transport Plan 4 deliver net zero transport by 2050
- Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP)
- Community Rail Partnership
 - Link with new Pedall community hub and Ashurst station
 - Link with spudWORKS creative hub and Sway station
 - Funding to engage with new and diverse audiences









'More' partnership

- New Forest Ambassadors keeping the Forest and its coastline clean almost 1000 registered!
- Visitor survey 22/23 over 700 responses, 15% arrived by sustainable transport
 - Will relaunch soon with questions to widen participation and reduce barriers
