For the avoidance of doubt the local requirements should confirm what we need (particularly for the local requirement of calculating floorspace)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Block plan including site access details • Existing and proposed elevations and floorplans in full. Definitions:

Major application: as defined in Article 2 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015. Includes applications for 10 or more dwellings or residential development on a site of 0.5 hectares or more; the provision of buildings of 1,000 square metres or more; and development carried out on a site having an area of 1 hectare or more.

Relevant application: An application where the criteria in column 2 in the local requirements table are met.
