10 projects to help increase

Projects delivering for nature Including:

2161 metres of hedgerows planted 819.1 ha of habitat improvement for biodiversity 137 trees planted 8 wildlife boxes installed 4 ponds created

Projects delivering for people

Including:

71 volunteers engaged through programme 1 project making landscape more inclusive for visitors

Projects delivering for place Including:

4 projects increasing the resilience of nature friendly sustainable farm businesses, contributing a more thriving local economy 2 projects where investment in machinery will help protect historic features by reducing disturbance of underground archaeological sites

Our main stakeholders include: NPA members (Parish council, local authority and Sec of State appointees), parent bodies of Panel representatives, farming and land managing community
