APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM MONITORING OFFICER

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Statute requires the Authority to designate one of its officers as the Monitoring Officer. The Monitoring Officer may not also be the Authority's Chief Finance Officer or the Chief Executive/Head of Paid Service.
- 1.2 The key functions of the Monitoring Officer include:-
 - oversight and reporting of the operation of the Authority's Constitutional arrangements and the decision making processes;
 - reporting on unlawfulness and maladministration;
 - investigating allegations of breach of the Code of Conducts; and
 - seeking rulings from the Authority's Independent Person(s).
- 1.3 Rosalind Alderman, the Authority's Solicitor and Monitoring Officer, will be leaving the Authority on 24 January 2025 and, whilst recruitment for a replacement is already underway, the need has arisen to appoint an Interim Monitoring Officer for the short term. Once a more formal appointment is made, the Authority will be asked to confirm that person as Monitoring Officer (ending the Interim term proposed here).
- 1.4 Officers will confirm the proposed candidate at the meeting who is willing and able to take on the role of Interim Monitoring Officer.

Recommendation:

Members formally appoint an Officer as Interim Monitoring Officer of the Authority, with effect from 24 January 2025 and for up to a maximum of six months or until a permanent appointment is made.
