Tree planting

Continuing our tree planting programme, we have recently been planting at:

- Highland Water
- Coppice of Linwood
- Sloden (starts this week)

A range of native species are being planted, including:

- 7,000 Oak
- Blackthorn
- Rowan
- Hazel





Heathland restoration & ground nesting bird season



Our survey with Hampshire Ornithological Society (HOS) revealed the highest ever numbers of woodlark recorded in the Forest

- The survey helps to measure the impact of our ongoing heathland restorations returning more of the right habitat for a range of wildlife
- This year we will working again with HOS to survey wader numbers

We are taking protective measures this ground nesting bird season

- A small number of car parks closed at the most sensitive locations
- Signage
- Public education campaign with partners



Fly tipping



On average, we dealt with one fly-tip every day of January 2025

- We continue to work with local partners including NFDC and the police on random spot checks on vehicles carrying waste
- We have recently extended these to work with private estates (Beaulieu and Longdown)

- Check anyone taking away your waste
